However, I personally know of a family that has been greatly harmed by a medical provider's refusal to amend the medical record with this additional information.

It was determined to be unfounded but when the mother would apply for jobs it would come up when the potential employer would do a background check. The unfounded accusation would show up. I knew this mother ten years after the initial accusation. The mother had never been able to get a regular job in all that time. She worked under the table and it negatively impacted the whole family.
