Our Credit Union is proud to partner with Healthy Homeworks, a Lewiston non-profit leading the Renter-2-Owner (R2O) program. This innovative initiative is transforming distressed downtown properties into high-quality, affordable condominiums for working families. Participants in the program not only gain access to homeownership but also receive valuable education on how to be successful homeowners. Our Credit Union supplements this by providing financial literacy training, helping to ensure participants are prepared for the financial responsibilities of ownership.

One of the most significant barriers Healthy Homeworks faces is the gap between the cost of rehabilitating these buildings and the price at which units can be sold while remaining affordable. Currently, the organization is relying on philanthropy to fill that gap. The pilot program outlined in LD 1167 would provide essential support for initiatives like this - enabling communities to preserve historic buildings, expand affordable housing options, and promote economic mobility.

This bill offers a creative, place-based solution to one of Maine's most pressing challenges: the shortage of affordable, high-quality housing for working families. It aligns public financing tools with community-driven redevelopment strategies, helping local organizations like Healthy Homeworks scale their impact.

We believe in the transformative power of homeownership - not just for individual families, but for entire neighborhoods. LD 1167 would help make that transformation possible in places that need it most.
