Dear ENR Committee Members,

Thank you for taking up LD 1507.

We live 3000 feet from fence line of the Sunoco terminal and four tanks from Portland pipeline. We experience burst emissions That cause headaches, nausea, swollen glands, coughing, and heart pain.

These fumes often Suffuse our home late at night when we don't have the opportunity to reduce our exposure. At times we wake up to our house filled with these toxic fumes.

We have used a DEP grab canister to verify that yes we are breathing in benzene levels that are well over the ambient air guidelines for Maine at our home during these burst emissions.

Golf which is now Sunoco was sued by the EPA in 2024 over shooting it's been seen credits at this facility. The neighborhood was Never notified of this EPA lawsuit. Neighborhood was never notified that they were exposed to illegal amounts of benzene.

It is a human right for us to be notified of potential exposures to dangerous VOC and hazardous air pollutants.

Thank you for moving this bill forward. It's a much needed health and safety measure.
