I am submitting comments in favor of LD 1065 An Act Regarding the Reduction and Recycling of Food Waste. LD 1065 will put Maine back in step with the positive stewardship models of the other New England states. Currently Maine is the only state in the region not employing food waste diversion programs like recycling and composting.
