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## **Testimony in Support of**

LD 1018, "An Act to Protect Health Care for Rural and Underserved Areas by Prohibiting Discrimination by Participants in a Federal Drug Discount Program"

Before the Joint Standing Committee on Health Coverage, Insurance, and Financial Services April 16, 2025

Senator Bailey, Representative Mathieson, and Esteemed Members of the Joint Standing Committee on Health Coverage, Insurance, and Financial Services, my name is Mattie Daughtry, and I proudly represent Senate District 23, which includes Brunswick, Freeport, Harpswell, Pownal, Chebeague Island, and part of Yarmouth.

Today I am pleased to offer testimony in support of LD 1018, "An Act to Protect Health Care for Rural and Underserved Areas by Prohibiting Discrimination by Participants in a Federal Drug Discount Program."

Programs that support Maine's rural health care infrastructure are critical. Let me repeat that: *Programs that support Maine's rural health care infrastructure are critical.* 

This winter, I had the opportunity to meet with leaders from Penobscot Bay Community Health Center. They see 60,000 patients on average per year. That means 1 in 9 Mainers are served by PCHC in Penobscot, Waldo, and Somerset Counties. This health care is a lifeline in this region. I learned that recent reductions in 340B Savings cost PCHC a whopping \$4.9 million in 2024. This is unacceptable and I believe we can change the rules in Maine to ensure our healthcare providers-especially those who complete extensive reporting like PCHC--can benefit from this program.

I thank Senator Bailey for bringing forward this meaningful legislation. I thank her, and members of this committee for fighting for protections and supports for rural providers.
