We rely on staff from 30 Mile to post critical information on the message boards at all boat ramps, including the "Clean, Drain, Dry" posters, information about invasive plants, and maps showing no wake zones on the lakes. This is an invaluable opportunity to educate boaters about items that are directly related to the health of our lakes, streams, and ponds, and is complementary to the information provided by the state. I recognize the need for consistency and clarity at boat ramps across the state and welcome educational information provided by the state. I respectfully request that local lake associations and other organizations that dedicate both huge volunteer efforts and considerable funding to protect our lakes be permitted to add lake and watershed specific information to the state's material.
