

MMA Testimony in Support of

LD 1326, An Act to Protect the Drinking Water for Consumers of Certain Water Systems by Establishing Maximum Contaminant Levels for Certain Perfluoroalkyl and Polyfluoroalkyl Substances

Senator Ingwersen, Representative Meyer and members of the Health and Human Services Committee, my name is Kate Dufour, and I am submitting testimony in support of LD 1326 on behalf of MMA's Legislative Policy Committee, which establishes the association's positions on all municipally relevant legislation.

From the perspective of municipal officials across the state, especially among those dealing with PFAS related challenges, LD 1326 simply presents an opportunity to bring state PFAS contaminant levels, monitoring and tracking requirements in line with those established by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. The changes proposed in the bill streamline the process and provide the consistency and predictability municipal officials need to comply with federal and state requirements.
