REALTORS® protect private property rights, build Maine communities, and grow our state's economy. Our members represent buyers and sellers involved in both residential and commercial real estate transactions. The Maine Association of REALTORS® supports LD 1657. The bill expands the use of tax increment revenue for affordable housing by including authorized project costs. As such, it is a well-reasoned approach to increase housing development in our state.

LD 1657 creates additional flexibility for financing, helps to reduce barriers to development, which is a key factor in Maine's housing shortage, and incentivizes construction of affordable housing. We do not have enough housing in Maine and need to increase development. This proposal will provide additional financial flexibility for development to help meet Maine's housing goals.
