Our department and our school have felt the impact of the chronic underfunding. We have had faculty leave, and, due to budgetary constraints, the positions have not been replaced. For example, I am the only full-time faculty member for Literacy Education in our department, and as a department chair, may only teach six credits per semester, and the other courses are taught by part-time faculty or full-time faculty members in other departments. Additionally, scholarship opportunities for our graduate students are very limited.
