It guarantees that an election with three or more candidates will result in a winner that's supported by the majority of voters. Ranked-choice voting will also prevent splitting the ticket, something that could certainly occur during the gubernatorial election next year.

I'm an independent voter and am often not satisfied with the candidates represented by the two major political parties. Ranked-choice voting allows me to rank my preferred candidate first, knowing that whatever the results may be, the tabulation will always guarantee a majority winner. Ranked-choice voting levels the playing field and gives independent candidates a better chance. Over time, the more that we use ranked-choice voting, the more that the results will benefit the voter and improve voter satisfaction and confidence in the electoral process. Overall, ranked-choice voting is not partisan, nor does it favor one political party over another.
