I am writing to express my opposition to LD 1379 An Act to Require Public Health Warnings to Be Posted and Provided by Firearm Dealers and Gunsmiths. Maine law Title 25 section 2012 already requires a basic safety brochure to be included with the sale of firearms as well as a trigger lock demonstration and conspicuous posting of information relating to firearm safety programs. Any requirements beyond these are completely unnecessary. The proposed requirement that firearm dealers or gunsmiths post a propagandized warning sign is nothing more than an attempt to demonize and harass those who are engaged in constitutionally protected activities. LD 1379 ought not to pass.
