The current testing requirements for AU TYM are simply too low- forcing ridiculous testing & sampling practices that are outdated and honestly, not keeping the customers any safer. Maine TYM count is the lowest in the entire state. Other states have reasonable TYM count of 100,000 cfus and have ZERO reports of unhealthy or unsafe cannabis products, or adverse health effects from said products.

Whether it's improving access, streamlining rules, or helping small businesses compete fairly, responsible policy changes can make a big difference. I appreciate seeing progress that balances safety, economic opportunity, and personal freedom.
