During that time I have observed careful stewardship of the Austin Carey Forest by the Park staff and their local consulting forester, Barrie Brusila.

I strongly support the demonstration forestry mission of the Austin Carey Forest, but I also understand the challenges that the Park staff have in fulfilling their responsibilities to this parcel given the distance from Millinocket to Harpswell. An organization with a similar mission but with stronger regional presence would be an ideal owner. If the Park Authority were able to transfer this forest to an organization that was capable of fulfilling its purpose as a sustainable forestry and wildlife management demonstration area the public and the land would be well served.
