I have witnessed the immense need for support to folks who experienced their world view system change forever. They are managing the guilt, sadness and loss on a scale never imagined in our State.

In my work with Maine Resiliency Center over the past 16 months, I have provided mental health support in the form of individual support, grief group work and psychoeducation on grief, and loss, resiliency and trauma informed education including coping with symptoms that impact their daily life. I have witnessed the improved work/life balance as community members leaned in for support. They are moving forward along with their families due in part to the level of support they receive. Our State will forever be changed, and offering supportive options for all Mainers, is vital to increase resiliency and healthy community members.
