My name is Kathleen Glennon and I am a resident of Topsham, ME (6 Kestrel Dr.)
and I am testifying in opposition to LDs 233,868,1002,1134and1704. I submit this as
a member of my Unitarian Universalist faith tradition which firms and promotes
justice, equity and compassion in human relations and the inherent worth and dignity
of every person. I am a member of the Unitarian Universalist church of Brunswick
and MUUSAN, the Maine UU state Advocacy Network which supports legislation
which embodies these values.

I believe these LEs should NOT become law because they are simply WRONG. They
dehumanize people and benefit no one. It is unconstitutional to ban trans athletes from
playing sports; Banning trans children is harmful to all girls and women; Banning
trans children from bathrooms and other places creates prejudice and fear that any
child could be required to have their genitals examined or undergo a DNA test which
is invasive and traumatizing. And even DNA may not be reliable.

I want ALL children to thrive and all children to have the opportunity play sports with
the teams that best reflect their gender identity.

I urge you to vote NOT TO PASS on LDs 233,868,1002, 1134 and 1704. I also urge
