Thank you for the opportunity to submit testimony. My name is Ted LaCrone, a resident of Portland, and I'm here on behalf of HopeGateWay, a community of faith in Portland, Maine. I am writing to vehemently oppose LD 233, LD 868, LD 1002, LD 1134, LD 1704, LD 1337, LD 1432, and LD 380. As a person of faith, I write to you with deep concern about these bills that seek to restrict access to sports teams, public restrooms, health care, and legal protections against discrimination based on gender identity.

My faith tells me we must protect the most vulnerable among us. Trans youth are one of the most vulnerable communities within this state and the country. These bills are harmful because they further marginalize an already marginalized group of students and adults who have the same right to a safe, supportive environment as their peers. To deny them the right to participate in their daily life based on who they are is unjust, unfair, and anti-Christian. Finally, here in Maine, we share a deep understanding of community, care for our neighbors and respect for people to live life on their own terms- even if we disagree.
