My name is Lucie Bauer. I am a resident of Rockland and I am testifying in opposition to LD 1337. I submit this testimony as a member of my Unitarian Universalist faith tradition, which affirms and promotes justice, equity and compassion in human relations and the inherent worth and dignity of every person. I am a member of the First Universalist Church in Rockland and of MUUSAN, the Maine Unitarian Universalist Network which embodies these values.
