Senator Carney, Representative Kuhn and members of the Maine Legislative Judiciary Committee, I am Mike McClellan and I live in Raymond, Maine. I am a former Maine State Rep. (125th -127th) and I am writing as I am away when you meet on this bill. I am fully in support of LD 1002, An Act to Protect Children's Identification by Requiring Public Schools to Use the Name and Gender Specified on a Child's Birth Certificate.

I believe some issues are so clear, it is an incredible time we live in that someone needs to put a piece of legislation in to suggest to our elected leaders this is the correct action.
