Maine's current laws are in compliance with the Maine Human Rights Act and Title IX. This proposed law is in violation of both, and if passed, will create immediate legal challenges that will prove time consuming and costly, for no reason other than assuaging the complaints of those who wish to legalize discrimination against trans Mainers. Moreover, this bill is only one of several with the same basic aim. How did that come to be?
