Senator Carney, Representative Kuhn, and esteemed members of the judiciary committee:

My name is Barbara Freeman, and I am a resident of Falmouth, Maine. I am testifying in SUPPORT of LD1259, An Act to Enhance Public Safety in Maine by Defining the Relationship Between Local and Federal Law Enforcement. Such communities will strengthen our state, and for these reasons, I urge the committee to vote OUGHT TO PASS on LD 1259.
