LD 1911

I am writing today to ask you to pass LD 1911. By sealing records after 5-10 years, formerly incarcerated people would be able to obtain employment, education, and resources that would otherwise be denied to them. Records would not be destroyed and would still be able to be viewed by law enforcement and background checks for childcare, and it would not apply at all to class A felonies. Several other states have clean slate laws, which has led to lower recidivism rates, especially with a strong support system for re-entry. Please pass LD 1911!
