My name is Hailie Ravanis, and I am a student at APC in Biddeford, Maine. I support LD 332, which makes it mandatory for any person who commits gross sexual assault or aggravated sex trafficking on children to be sentenced to no less than 25 years in prison.

I think this is important because there are thousands of children trafficked every year, and many of those kids don't get the justice they deserve. These kids are already traumatized; now imagine being one of those kids, and the person who did that is walking around freely. In addition, these crimes are rarely reported, which makes it hard to find statistics because we are never really gonna know whether this helps, or stops it.
