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I am a recently retired teacher and current school board member. I am concerned with the increased time students are spending on devices. Technology companies have promised results that students are not achieving. I strongly support this bill, however, I caution your means of surveying. After teaching 35 years, I witnessed the changes in classrooms and can testify the increased use of technology has not improved learning and our test scores reflect it. I believe younger teachers and administrators have incorporated technology into their schools and classrooms and they are reluctant to give up or decrease use of technology. As a school board member I am trying to draft policy on technology use in classrooms and have received push back from the principal, staff and other board members. They are just ignorant to the research on the adverse effects of technology on children. Along with surveying school districts, please read the research. It is profound.
