To whom it may concern:

I am writing to express our firm's concerns with LD 2018 prohibiting the pooling of risk and administration for self-insured PFML plans. We are a commercial construction company in business since 1947 with locations in Fairfield and formerly Portland, Maine. We employ +/- 100 trades people, all residents of Maine.

We object to LD 2018 as it limits our ability to control expenses related to the PFML Act. This puts us at a distinct disadvantage when bidding against small or out-of-state contractors. We respectfully request that the Maine Department of Labor continues to allow us to deliver PFML benefits as efficiently as possible to remain competitive in Maine while maintaining great compensation and benefits to our hard-working Maine employees.
