Dear Chair Carney, Chair Kuhn and honorable members of the Joint Committee on Judiciary.

My name is Sophie Schuele and I live in Brunswick.

I am writing today to urge you to vote ought to pass on LD 2106,  
An Act to Prohibit the Disclosure of Nonpublic Records Without Proper Judicial Review.

This act protects the rights of Maine residents as they go about their daily life in public school, a college or university, a health care facility, a child care facility, a family child care provider or public library even if a single person in the location provides voluntary consent permitting a law enforcement officer engaged in immigration enforcement or supporting immigration enforcement to enter that nonpublic area.

This would protect Maine's public schools, hospitals, daycares, and libraries from ICE, as they continue to terrorize our neighbors and community.

The recent actions of ICE have violated the most critical tenants of American freedoms. The violence and discrimination with which they operate is appalling.
