Dear Chair Carney, Chair Kuhn and honorable members of the Joint Committee on Judiciary.

My name is Helen Worden and I live in Portland, ME.

I am writing today to urge you to vote ought to pass on LD 2106,

*An Act to Prohibit the Disclosure of Nonpublic Records Without Proper Judicial Review.*

This act protects the rights of Maine residents as they go about their daily life in public school, a college or university, a health care facility, a child care facility, a family child care provider or public library even if a single person in the location provides voluntary consent permitting a law enforcement officer engaged in immigration enforcement or supporting immigration enforcement to enter that nonpublic area.

**This would protect Maine's public schools, hospitals, daycares, and libraries from ICE, as they continue to terrorize our neighbors and community.**

No resident of Maine should feel unsafe or scared to enter and use these vital spaces.
