I am writing in support of the urgent passage of LD 2106. No Maine parent should be afraid to send their child to school, drop them at daycare or take them to the doctor or a library. LD 2106 would deny ICE access to Maine's schools, daycares, healthcare facilities, or libraries without a valid judicial warrant. That last part is most important....without a valid judicial warrant. The bill clarifies the legal prohibitions of ICE actions, which can be murky at present. Most urgently, LD 2106 provides a safeguard against further trauma of children and recognizes that the current cruel practice of going after Maine children is appalling and inhumane. Our children, teachers, day care providers, librarians and health care need to be able to go about their "jobs" of learning, teaching and caring without threats and harassments by ICE. Please pass LD 2106 to stop this madness and abuse of power.
