to the Committee on Judiciary**



Senator Carney, Representative Kuhn, and distinguished members of the Committee:

I urge you to vote Ought To Pass on LD 2106.

I am a retired teacher, a parent and new grandparent. I cannot imagine a situation where a federal police force wants to pick up immigrants, without a judicial warrant, in spaces where our children spend time learning – such as schools, libraries, and daycare facilities. In the same way a federal police force in our hospitals, where we are at our most vulnerable, is unthinkable. Please vote Ought to Pass, and protect Maine’s most vulnerable in institutions and facilities where they have the right to feel safe from immigration tactics/actions without a judicial warrant to be in those spaces.
