As a Maine resident and American citizen, I oppose the unwarranted deployment of ICE in our communities. These federal actions create fear, separate families and erode trust in our institutions. LD 2106 will ensure proper judicial review of ICE operations in Maine, preventing ICE from conducting immigration enforcement without a valid judicial warrant in schools, hospitals and healthcare facilities, daycares, and libraries. LD 2106 also prevents ICE from obtaining private records in the event they enter nonpublic areas of these spaces.

Every Mainer, regardless of immigration status, should be able to attend school, go to a doctor's appointment, or simply visit their local library without fear or the threat of intimidation from ICE.
