Hello, my name is Kylie Thibodeau. I am testifying in support of LD 2106: An Act to Prohibit the Disclosure of Nonpublic Records Without Proper Judicial Review, which has a public hearing on 1/29/2026.

I am from Raymond, Maine. I am a current student at Columbia University. One thing I have always appreciated about Mainers is our fervent care for our neighbors and the institutions that uphold our communities. Both of these are currently under attack.

LD 2106 is about the law and justice. It would ensure proper judicial review of ICE operations in Maine, preventing them from conducting immigration enforcement without a valid judicial warrant in schools, medical facilities, daycares, and libraries. It also prevents ICE from obtaining private records if they enter nonpublic areas of these spaces.

Every Mainer, regardless of immigration status, should be granted the freedom to be able to attend school, go to the doctor, or visit their local library without fear and the threat of intimidation from ICE. This bill is a step toward making this a reality. Please vote “ought to pass” on LD 2106.
