I am a Maine educator, and I am deeply concerned about the welfare of all students in our public schools. For that reason, I write in support of LD 2106. Schools cannot effectively fulfill their responsibilities—educating students, providing essential services, and ensuring children are fed and cared for—if families do not trust that schools will protect student information and maintain safe learning environments. LD 2106 establishes clear limits on the disclosure of student information by requiring a judicial warrant, which helps preserve that trust while respecting due process. For these reasons, I urge the Legislature to enact LD 2106.
