Members of the Judiciary Committee,

I am writing this testimony in support of LD 2106

LD 2106 would ensure proper judicial review of ICE operations in Maine and would prevent ICE from conducting immigration enforcement without a valid judicial warrant in schools, hospitals and healthcare facilities, daycares, and libraries.

LD 2106 also prevents ICE from obtaining private records in the event they enter non-public areas of these spaces.

Every Mainer, regardless of immigration status, should be able to attend school, go to a doctor's appointment, or simply visit their local library without fear or the threat of intimidation from ICE.

I urge you to support LD 2106.
