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Hello and thank you for your time today. As a nurse and a midwife who has worked both in hospital and community settings, I understand more than most the necessity to protect the vulnerable. The sick, children and their families. It is never appropriate for ICE to enter these spaces, spaces that are supposed to be safe. Spaces where children can learn without fear. Libraries are community hubs, a space that should be welcoming for all people, and again should not be a place of fear. These public spaces daycares, schools libraries and hospitals are not appropriate spaces for agents to enter, especially without a valid judicial warrant. The harm that is caused by separating children from their families or inflicting more pain and suffering on those who are already experiencing enough of that is cruel and unjust. People have the right to feel safe navigating these public spaces without fear. We have to face the reality that federal ICE agents are enacting racist, violent horrors across the country. We need to do everything we can as a state to protect people. We know that the campaign of ICE is to spread fear, not to protect the safety of the public. They're not acting in goodwill or good faith. We need to do everything we can to bolster against that kind of hatred. It is not who we are.
