Constituent Letter in Support of LD 2106, An Act to Prohibit the Disclosure of Nonpublic Records Without Proper Judicial Review | Hearing on January 29, 2026

Dear Committee,

My name is Elizabeth withee and I am a constituent from Gorham, Maine.

I am writing to voice my support for LD 2106 to ensure proper judicial review of ICE operations in Maine, preventing ICE from conducting immigration enforcement without a valid judicial warrant in schools, hospitals and healthcare facilities, daycares, and libraries. ICE must be prevented from obtaining private records in the event they enter nonpublic areas of these spaces.

Every Mainer, regardless of immigration status, should be able to attend school, go to a doctor's appointment, or simply visit local businesses without fear or the threat of intimidation and violence from ICE.

It is unjust for federal agents' actions to create fear, separate families, and erode trust in our institutions. The intimidation, violence, and unlawful behavior from ICE threatens civic participation and our economy. I am calling on you to provide the checks and balances that this state deserves.
