Constituent Letter in Support of LD 2106, An Act to Prohibit the Disclosure of Nonpublic Records Without Proper Judicial Review | Hearing on January 29, 2026

Dear Chairwoman Kuhn, Chairwoman Carney, and members of the Judiciary Committee,

My name is Alex Redfield, I am a resident of South Portland, Maine.

I am writing to voice my support for **LD 2106** to ensure proper judicial review of ICE operations in Maine, preventing ICE from conducting immigration enforcement without a valid judicial warrant in schools, hospitals and healthcare facilities, daycares, and libraries. ICE must be prevented from obtaining private records in the event they enter nonpublic areas of these spaces.

I have personally witnessed my daughter's friends, just five and six years old, rush to their parents' vehicles in fear after school, knowing that ICE operations both in Minnesota and just across the bridge in Portland have targeted parents on school grounds and at bus stops without any legal consideration or justification whatsoever. The provisions set forth in LD 2106 are a modest and meaningful safeguard to protect our neighbors in essential public spaces.

I support LD 2106 without reservation. Thank you in advance for your consideration, time, and service.
