To the judiciary committee,

I am writing as a resident of Maine to express my support of LD 2106, a bill to keep ICE out of hospitals, schools, libraries, and daycares. I, like many Mainers, was surprised to learn that this isn't already common practice. I feel even more strongly that this act must be passed upon discovering that it was one of Trump's first executive orders that eliminated these protections.

Right now, ICE officers are kidnapping citizens and immigrants on legal status, and they are doing this without warrants.
