My child's school has had an alarming decline in attendance, and many of our friends are afraid to put their children in daycare, which affects their ability to show up to work as well. Our family fears for those who need medical care, but are afraid to go to the hospital because of the violent acts of ICE. This has reached a point of disrupting and harming the well being and public health of our entire community. LD 2106 would help ease fears, and mitigate risk to vulnerable members of our community by requiring federal immigration enforcement to obtain a warrant.
