Honorable members of the Judiciary Committee:

My name is Morgana Warner-Evans. I'm a resident of West Bath and I'm here to testify in support of LD 2106. Mainers should be able to go to work and school and not worry about being beaten or taken from their family without a warrant.

I lived in Portland for 4.5 years and have been closely following what's happening there. Since ICE increased their operations in Maine, and since they have been kidnapping people with work permits and student visas, I've been very concerned about friends of mine who are in Maine on this kind of documentation. All of them are working and depend on their jobs to pay their rent. They should be able to continue to go to work safely.

LD 2106 would protect workers by preventing ICE from entering several places of work without a judicial warrant, ensuring that innocent people are not kidnapped.
