LD1847 should not pass. With over 500 previously submitted pieces of testimony, it is abundantly clear that the people of Maine do not want this to pass. This bill would limit patient access, place burdensome fees, costs, and labor on small operators who are already facing difficult times in the economy. The limits of THC mentioned in this bill would prevent patients with severe conditions from receiving the medicine they need. Maine medical already has mandatory tracking via trip tickets, transaction logs and internal tracking, and testing. OCP is tasked with collecting and testing dispensary and caregiver products on an annual basis. This bill should not pass.
