I wanted to share our support for LD 2141, which provides funds for the Lake Water Quality Restoration and Protection Fund. This funding is especially important for keeping our lakes and the ecosystems around them healthy.

Many of Maine's lakes depend on older dams to keep water levels steady and protect the environment and communities. But if these dams aren't well-maintained, they can cause serious problems like bad water quality, shoreline erosion, harm to fish, and more risks to homes and public safety downstream.
