Support for LD 785, An Act to Enact the Remaining Recommendations of the Task
Force on Changes to the Maine Indian Claims Settlement Implementing Act

To our esteemed Sen. Carney, Rep. Kuhn and members of the Judiciary Committee,
I am wholeheartedly in support of LD 785. The tribes of the Wabanaki Alliance are
indisputably sovereign governments. As we citizens of the distinct United States hold
fast to the fundamental constitutional principle of inherent authority to locally
self-govern, how can we consciously deny the same to each of the tribes? The Maine
Indian Claims Settlement Act of 1980 was intended to be a living document; and
acknowledgment of its inefficacies in 2020, by way of convening the Task Force on
Changes, must be acted upon today.

It is in the best interest of us all to establish reciprocal, mutually respectful
relationships between the State of Maine and the individual tribes of the Wabanaki
Alliance. The consensus recommendations coming from the task force and addressed
in LD 785 exemplify such a pragmatic process and truth-based mindset. Passage
today is Maine's genuine commitment to upholding the basic human rights
foundational to social and economic justice, and lends itself to the well-being of the
lands, waters, and inhabitants of those ecosystems. Moreover, the financial and
human resources squandered by past litigation can be recommitted to actuating
environmental stewardship and economic development.

A simple affirmation of the ocean explorer Jaques Cousteau, "People protect what
they love.", resonates in this moment. I fully trust that when the Wabanaki birthright
kinship with their Mother is upheld through passage of LD 785, our communities will
be vitalized in myriad ways.
