Federal actions that threaten reimbursement for providers serving MaineCare patients are putting thousands of Mainers at risk of losing access to care.

Maine's family planning network provides essential health services that reach far beyond abortion care. These clinics deliver primary care, cancer screenings, behavioral health support, and preventive services to tens of thousands of people each year.

LD 335 would create stable, ongoing funding beginning in 2027 and help safeguard access to reproductive health care at a time of growing federal uncertainty.

I urge you to ensure that no Mainer loses care because of decisions made far from home by voting Ought to Pass on LD 335.
