As an engineer in the electric transmission line field, I personally have a lot to gain (like job security) from the data center boom. But I am still skeptical and unsure of whether this is the right choice.

I have seen firsthand how data centers are impacting the wants and needs of utilities all across the country. I do not like the idea that we will be reshaping our T&D grid to accommodate data centers instead of working towards clean, reliable energy for everyone. I do not like the fact that rates will be increased on individual consumers to support new infrastructure that will profit big corporations. That isn't fair, and it isn't right.

Not to mention the logistics of how data centers would be reasonably added to our grid. In New England, we don't have huge open swaths of land where we can have 200-ft ROWs for 765kV transmission lines like they do in Colorado, Texas, and Wyoming. We have narrow, congested utility corridors with a ton of vegetation which have limited options for extra-high voltage transmission. Without EHV transmission, I really doubt that our grid can handle the added load of data centers while still meeting the needs of everyday consumers.

Maine has been ahead of the curve on so many instances when it comes to keeping big corporations from making money in our state at our expense. Please support LD407, including a temporary moratorium on large data center approvals. We need to watch and see how this plays out. We need time to decide if this works for us, or if it just makes money for out-of-state companies. Please do not fall to the pressure of people saying we have to act RIGHT NOW or we will MISS OUT!!!
