AARP Maine Testimony in favor of LD 258 Part "TT" Transferring \$30,000,000 from the unappropriated surplus of the General Fund to the Maine State Housing Authority for the Rural Affordable Rental Housing Program and the Low-income Housing Tax Credit Program

Greetings Senator Rotundo, Representative Sachs and honorable members of the Joint Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs and Honorable Members of the Joint Select Committee on Housing. My name is Bridget Quinn, and I am an Associate State Director for Advocacy and Outreach with AARP Maine. Today, on behalf of our 200,000 Maine members, I am testifying in favor of housing provisions included in LD 258.

AARP is the nation's largest nonprofit, nonpartisan organization dedicated to empowering people 50 and older to choose how they live as they age. Right here in Maine, we work to strengthen communities and advocate for what matters most to families: health security, financial stability and personal fulfillment.

For nearly 60 years, AARP has been fighting to make our all our communities great places to live. This means having access to safe, affordable and accessible housing. The combination of a shortage in rental housing, rising development costs and stagnant incomes are among the factors driving the growing housing affordability crisis affecting U.S. cities¹. The pandemic resulted in an unprecedented rising in housing costs, leaving home prices 38.6% above before the pandemic took hold.²

According to Statista/AARP analysis of data available by United States Census Bureau (USCB), 609 individuals 55+ are expected to be unhoused in Maine in 2023. Nearly 964 people 55+ are expected to be evicted. When considering people of all ages, that number increases to nearly 2,161 people facing evection and 1,367 experiencing homelessness.

None of our communities are immune, either. The numbers vary county by county, but in every county of our state, individuals are at risk of being evicted. I've provided a breakdown of counties based on AARP Data with my testimony.
