- I have been a landlord since 1972. I have owned a 50-unit trailer park, multi-unit, and singlefamily homes. At one time, I managed 65 units. I have mostly provided affordable housing to low-income tenants.
- I am speaking in SUPPORT of this Bill.
- I am a member of a landlord group that strives to inform and educate. Each year we invite the lead advocate from the City of Bangor to come and give a presentation on the irreversible harm of lead poisoning, mostly affecting children.
- Providing funding to reduce lead poisoning is a worthwhile cause. I feel priority should be given to landlords who accept vouchers. I know of some landlords who are hesitant to take vouchers because there may be lead in their building, and they cannot afford to abate the lead problem.
- Maybe it would encourage more landlords and property managers to take vouchers if they could receive financial assistance with the lead abatement cost. This would provide more rental opportunities for those with children in need of safe housing for their families.
