I support of Id 1530 on-site consumption medical cannabis.

Senator Hickman and Representative Supica and honorable members of the Veterans and Legal Affairs Committee, good morning and thank you for hosting this hearing.

I support patients and adults 21 and over being able to attend social events and consume cannabis.
