The difference between a young student who attended a preschool program versus a student who did not attend a preschool program is obvious and substantial

I cannot overemphasize the value of public pre-K as a critical stepping stone for our children's later educational journey Early childhood is a vital period for acquiring fundamental skills. Access to quality pre-K education plays an important role in developing these skills, fostering a love for learning, and narrowing the gap between children from diverse socio-economic backgrounds

Speaking of narrowing the gap between children from diverse socio-economic backgrounds, publicly available pre-K can help parents who are unable to pay for early childcare return to the workforce a year earlier

By broadening the availability of public pre-K opportunities through child care centers, family child care, and Head Start programs, we not only secure stable funding for these indispensable services but also support working families by offering comprehensive care A diverse pre-K delivery system encompassing public schools, child care centers, family child care, and Head Start programs will best cater to the needs of our children, families, and communities in Maine
