I make \$14 an hour as a childcare teacher and I am only able to work 24 hours a week. Daycare for my infant is \$55 a day. Let alone the additional \$20 a day for any aftercare. I may need for my Kindergartener. While we have two incomes, our other income doesn't account for childcare and that math doesn't add up to survival. We deserve better. My children deserve to live a solid life. We deserve to not struggle. PLEASE vote in favor of LD1726.
