Re: Testimony in OPPOSITION to LD 1619, An Act to Improve Maine's Reproductive Privacy Laws

I vehemently oppose LD 1619, An Act to Improve Maine's Reproductive Privacy Laws as well as the other two abortion bills LD 776, Resolution, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution of Maine to Establish the Right to Bodily Autonomy, and LD 1343, An Act to Protect the Reproductive Freedom of Maine People by Preempting the Field of Abortion Regulation.
