Hello, members of the committee, My name is Hannah Penney, I live in Topsham. First, thank you all for serving our great state.

This bill is not good for Maine, and should be voted down by all our lawmakers.

We trust you all to make laws that have Mainers best interest in mind, that keep us safe, and keeps Maine thriving. This bill doesn't allow for our youngest and most innocent to thrive.

I am 5 weeks postpartum from having my own baby. We spent 6 days in the NICU at Maine Medical center where we saw parents fighting for their babies to get better along side the drs, and nurses. Yet, drs and nurses who take an oath to save life, would also take it. They would take the lives of 3rd trimester babies, knowing that babies in the early second trimester can and have survived outside the womb.

There is no such medical threat to a woman or her unborn baby that a 3rd trimester abortion would be necessary for lifesaving measures. A full term, fully formed baby can be born via cesarean in the case a mother would need the pregnancy to end. For the baby, it is wrong, and misguided to think that taking its life is less cruel than having them be born with some illness, or deformity, where they can then recieve medical attention.
